Practice profile:

Gynecology

Half to three-quarter time position could be employed through SEHS or as an independent practitioner. Could also co-locate in one of our family practice clinics.

Family Practitioner and General Internist

Candidates may have their choice of practice options:

Option 1 Group practice with four young family practitioners (3 male, 1 female). This group of well trained physicians recently moved to their new clinic (Eastern Oregon Medical Associates) adjacent to the SEHS. Medicare certified rural health clinic.

Option 2 Group practice with one senior family practitioner in a well established and well respected clinic (Baker Clinic) adjacent to the hospital. Medicare certified rural health clinic.

Physicians in the community:

We have nineteen physicians in the area ranging from their early 30's to mid 60's. Our local medical staff is comprised of seven family practitioners, two general surgeons, one orthopedic surgeon, one internist, six emergency room physicians (who provide coverage 24/7), one radiologist and one ophthalmologist. Our physicians cover 17,000 members of the community.
